

LEARNING STYLES

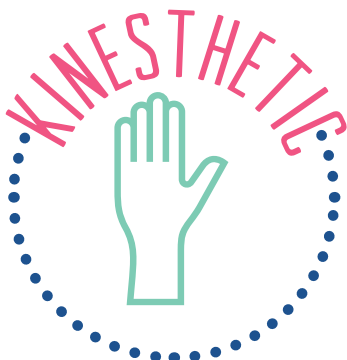

- Likes to **see** to learn
- Prefers to look at images, diagrams and patterns and gravitates toward colorful images presented in an interesting layout.
- Use a **colorful note** or **picture** to convey important information

- Likes to **hear** to learn
- Good at remembering song lyrics and rhymes
- Prefer to listen to instructions and often learn best from hearing things and then talking them out
- Use a **word, phrase** or **rhyme** to convey important information



- Likes to **move** to learn
- Use all senses - touch, sight, taste, smell, hearing - to experience things and enjoy using role playing to place themselves into the situation
- Use a **motion** or **gesture** to convey important information & allow **movement breaks**
